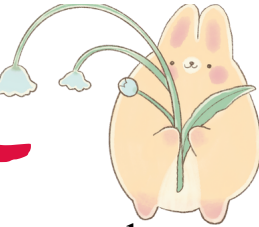

BUILDING BACK BEAUTIFUL



Revitalization of our long neglected common areas has started! We booked 42 volunteer hours cleaning up the McCoy Rd & Keller Springs entrance: removing dead plants and the drip irrigation system as well as pruning shrubs. The crape myrtle trees and the overgrown liriopie at Overture and Keller Springs were trimmed back. We hired Martinez Tree Service to cut back the overgrown Red Tip Photinias on Keller Springs between McCoy & Homer Rd. This will fill back in and clear the sidewalk.

A new drip irrigation will be installed at the main entrance on McCoy & Keller Springs along with ~20 new plants. Additional clean-up dates have been tentatively scheduled (weather permitting) on Feb 24 & Mar 2 9am-noon for the crape myrtle trees on Jackson Rd and general spring cleaning in all areas. 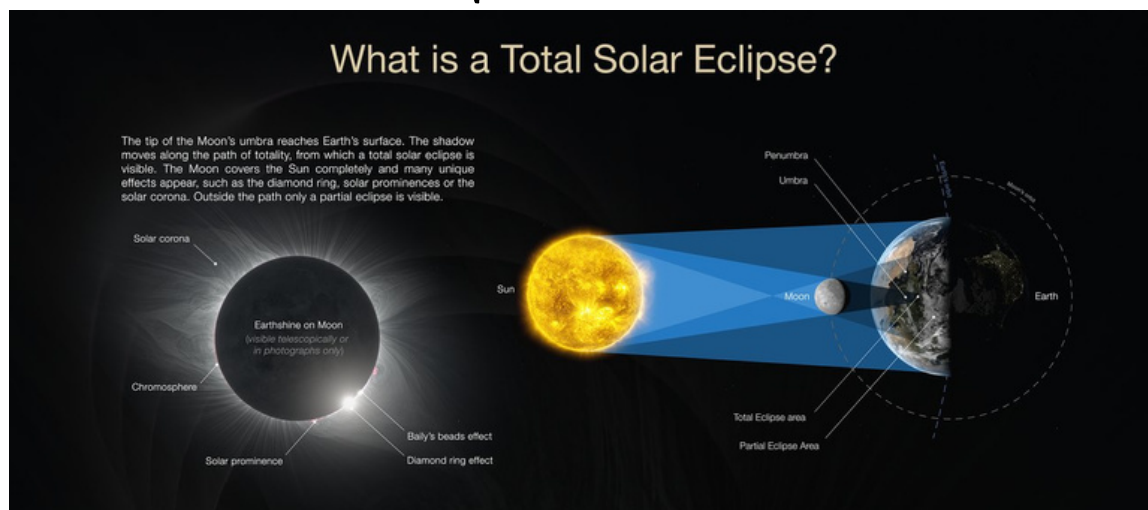

Spring Couscous Bowl with Lemon Feta Vinaigrette

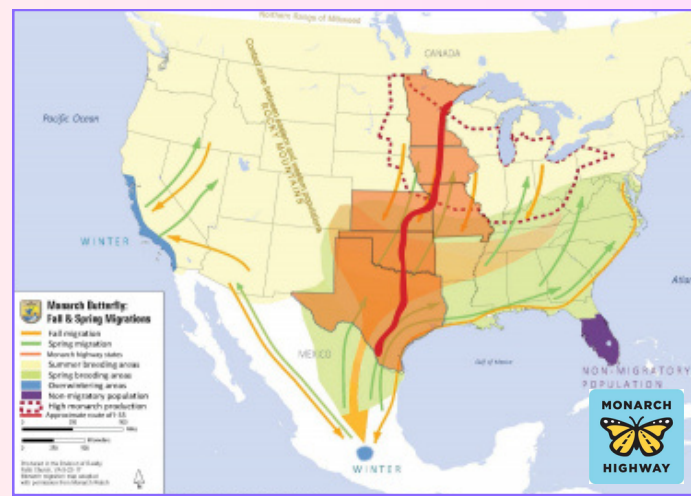
